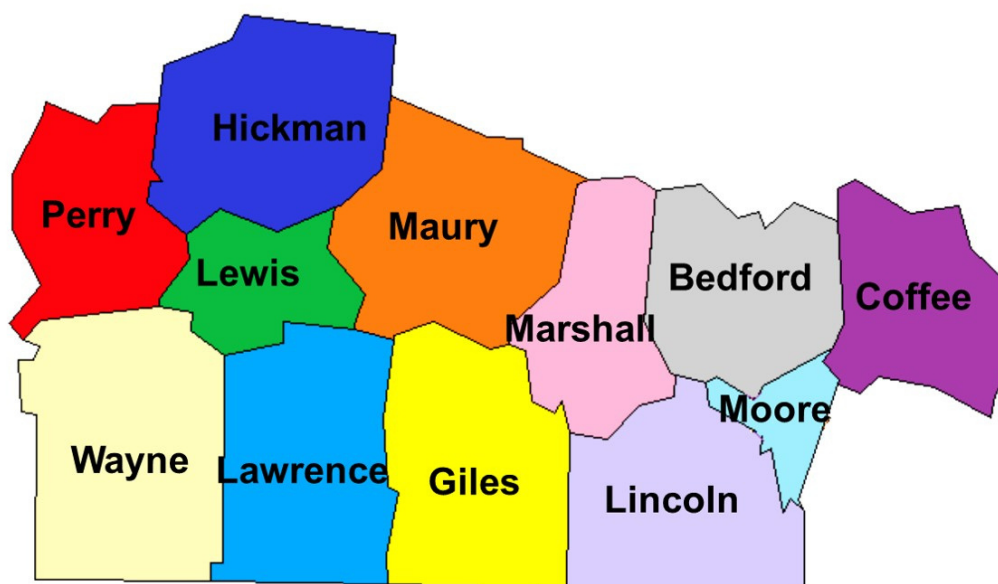

The Coalition has purchased Geri chairs for use by Coalition partners. Geri chairs are useful for those with mobility issues and can also be used for non-ambulatory patients who have difficulty sitting upright in a conventional wheelchair. These chairs offer the convenience of wheeled mobility that most recliners don't have. These assets are housed at TriStar ER in Spring Hill.

The Coalition has purchased a 45kw towable generator with compatible 50-amp twist lock plugs, 2" hitch, DOT approved trailer w/brakes, leveling jacks and spare tire. This generator expands and compliments the current capabilities of furnishing clean power to locations performing critical needs during times of planned events as well as manmade or natural emergencies. This asset is housed at Maury OEM and was recently used by this agency at Mule Day.

During the Gatlinburg wildfire, the Tennessee Department of Health used the emPOWER Emergency Response Outreach Individual dataset to rapidly identify at-risk individuals that may be in danger and partnered with the National Guard to conduct life-saving outreach to over 70 oxygen dependent at-risk individuals, one of which was evacuated to receive medical care.
- **Identify deployable equipment and resources intended to be shared in an emergency**
