FEMA Burn Table Top Exercise- 4/13, this is a public health multi-agency/multi-disciplinary activity. Only one person from each agency is required to count the agency present for participation. Due to the size of this exercise we will be split between two locations. FEMA will be conducting the exercise. SID numbers required for each participant and are required to participate. If you need assistance, Pat will be able to help. No other information will be released until two weeks prior to the incident. We are the only HCC in the state that is involved in this class.

The goal is to be able to hold 20 burn patients within the region within 24 hours. If you want to be considered part of the burn surge plan-please let us know. The burn surge hospitals will be partnered with the surge hospitals for tele-medicine, supplies, and education.

Brought up by Kathy: Members are considered active if they met the 80% requirement to be active. We need to re-evaluate this and make an adjustment-75% suggested.

Motion made to change to 75% by Randall Parker, passed unanimously.
